Long Term Success of Holy Cross

You may recall that earlier this year the Congregational Council identified the Long-Term Success of Holy Cross as one of our key priorities for this year and going forward. This is the first in a series of newsletter articles that will take place over the next four months to share with you our progress, and ultimately elicit your support.

Admittedly, a significant amount of attention and work has been recently placed towards the Roof & Building Project and the re-opening after the COVID pandemic. However, unseen and arguably more significant to the future of Holy Cross, is the Leadership Team's work on the Long-Term Success priority and the changes necessary to assure our future success.

There are several factors driving this need for change:

- 1) The long-time trend of spending more than we earn, each month, even though we have trimmed expenses.
- 2) The continuing decline of membership. Certainly, this trend is not specific to Holy Cross, nevertheless it is important for us to reverse this decline.
- 3) We continue to experience a decline of volunteer support and a continued reliance of a few loyal members. Since Holy Cross does not have a large staff, volunteerism is critical to accomplishing the work of the church.

All of these factors are not recent developments; however the pandemic has made us more aware and has created a greater recognition of the importance in reversing these trends. Over the past several months the Leadership Team has wrestled with this issue and how to begin addressing a solution. We have concluded that finding other ELCA churches that are successful and willing to share their best practices is the most prudent way to go. As you would expect, most churches are struggling with similar concerns as ours. Fortunately, through Pastor Noah's network of colleagues, we found the Calvary Partner Network, an affiliate of Calvary Lutheran Church in Alexandria, Minnesota. We have had preliminary discussions with Pastor Hans Dahl of Calvary, and in fact they have assisted us with some valuable insights and learnings. Our Leadership Team believes it is worth pursuing further discussions and, over the next several months, we will begin to explore the possibility of a working relationship with the Calvary Partner Network. We will continue to share the results of our progress. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to give me or any of our Leadership Team a call.
